#### Application and Decision Dates for admission to 24-25 school year.

The following are the dates applicable for admission to Junior Infants

The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on **30/11/2023** 

The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is **18/12/2023** 

The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is **\*14/1/2024**
